

Definitions

- A community is <u>a set of populations of different species sharing the same habitat.</u>
- Biodiversity describes <u>the variety of species living in a community.</u>

Main components of biodiversity

Component	Description
Species richness of a community	Number of species in the community
Relative abundance	Number of individuals of a particular species in relation to the total number of individuals in the community

Main types of interaction between individuals of a community

Interaction	Description
Competition	Interaction between living organisms that seek access to the same
	resource in their habitat.
Predation	Interaction between two living organisms in which one feeds on the other.
Mutualism	Interaction between two living organisms that benefits both organisms.
Commensalism	Interaction between two living organisms in which one organism benefits
	from the relationship, while the other remains unaffected.
